As Health Educator, Digital Storyteller you will harness your creativity and lived experiences to drive health equity by developing educational, interactive, engaging, and multi-faceted digital content on Peer Health Exchange's platforms, like TikTok, Instagram, YouTube and Peer Health Exchange's unique virtual community (in initial phases) to support young people in learning about their social, physical, and mental health.

Two different opportunities for Health Educator, Digital Storytelling are available.

You may apply for **one** or **both** opportunities.

- **Social Media Content Creators Training Program**

Members of this six-month cohort receive free training in digital storytelling and social media to create powerful, engaging media sparking social change and promoting inclusive health content.

- Commit 2-5 hours per week, for six months
- Attend weekly trainings, workshops and working group meet-ups
- Learn to create new media, participate in brainstorming, scriptwriting and pitch sessions; and practice meeting deadlines by recording and delivering content.

- **Short Testimonials for Peer Health Exchange's unique virtual community (in initial phases).**

- Create one or more video testimonials on a unique platform Peer Health Exchange is developing to support youth health and wellbeing.
- Selected applicants receive Visa cards as compensation (\$75 for training and creation of the first video; \$50 for each additional video testimonial made)
- This opportunity will require 4-10 hours total, throughout February and March.

Minimum Qualifications:

- Demonstrate a strong passion for Peer Health Exchange's mission, and a desire and an ability to build strong relationships across lines of social difference, specifically race, class, gender, and sexuality.
- Willingness to work directly with Peer Health Exchange staff, and other media and nonprofit professionals through coaching sessions
- Desire to serve as a health equity ambassador on camera bringing your experiences and identities to life through digital storytelling
